Sir Henry Wood (1869-1944), founded the famous Promenade Concerts firstly at Queens Hall and then relocated to the larger Royal Albert Hall. His ashes were placed with the Holy Sepulchre Church also known as the National Musicians' Church. His bronze bust resides all year in the Royal Albert Hall with the laurel wreath taken with due ceremony to the Royal Albert Hall for the "Proms" every July for six weeks and placed on a plinth beneath the vast organ.

Tradition has it that in 975 in the Ward of Farringdon Without there began an unbroken connection between the Butchers' Company and Smithfield Market. The Charter for the Worshipful Company of Butchers was granted by James I in 1605. Five of the seven Halls were burned down during the Great Fire of London in 1666. HRH The Princess Royal is an Honorary Freeman of the Company and was installed as Master of the Butchers in 2010.
